UNREQUESTED DONATIONS DISTRACTING FROM FLOOD RECOVERY EFFORTS IN BURKE SHIRE

Online donation platform <u>GIVIT</u> is calling on well-meaning Australians to use the official donation channel to assist people impacted by floods in the Burke Shire region earlier this month.

GIVIT works directly with councils, recovery outreach teams, charities and community groups in flood impacted regions that have begun receiving donation offers of goods they are not able to manage or store.

GIVIT Queensland Manager Christina Spehr said GIVIT is working with the Queensland Government and Burke Shire Council to manage donations of essential items that would overwhelm frontline services and distract them from their primary roles in response and recovery.

"Burke Shire Council have received well-meaning offers of donations from people across the country of goods they currently do not need, and are unable to store," said Christina.

"This also presents a logistics challenge as roads are still blocked and we don't want to see vehicles moving into the area that may hamper recovery efforts."

"Our message to people that want to help is please go to the <u>Northwest Queensland Flooding</u> <u>Appeal</u> on GIVIT.org.au to find out exactly what's needed."

100% of publicly donated funds received by GIVIT will be used to purchase essential items. Where possible, GIVIT uses donated funds to purchase items from local providers to support the economic recovery of impacted regions.
