Organisations assisting flood impacted people in Victoria encouraged to register with free donation platform GIVIT

Charities, services and community groups supporting people impacted by flooding across Victoria are encouraged to register with not-for-profit donation platform [GIVIT](https://www.givit.org.au) to access donations of essential items for the people they support.

GIVIT is a Victorian Government partner managing the donation of essential items and services for flood-affected Victorians. GIVIT works directly with councils, outreach teams, charities and community groups to make sure people get exactly what they need, when they need it.

GIVIT is free, private and easy to use and can provide critical and immediate support to flooded communities.

GIVIT National Manager Jo Beadle said donations include grocery and fuel vouchers as well as furniture, white goods and household essentials.

Charities, services and community groups supporting people impacted by floods can register with GIVIT for free to access thousands of donations offered by generous Australians and corporates.

Members of the public can donate money or essential items to impacted communities through www.givit.org.au/storms-and-flooding with 100% of publicly donated funds received by GIVIT going to affected communities.

Where possible, GIVIT uses donated funds to purchase items from local providers to support the economic recovery of impacted regions.
